Participation in the orchestra will be open to all interested youth in grades K–12. Younger players may be admitted based upon proficiency. Placement in the orchestra will be according to application information and recommendations of the orchestral staff. More than one orchestra may be formed, depending upon the number of applicants.

Orchestra practice and performance space will be provided by Century College. Orchestral staff will consist of local area music teachers and a director to be selected. Proposed fees are \$125 per semester. Partial fee subsidies may be available, depending on individual needs and funds available.
