The Stillwater Junior High Camerata Strings lead by Liz Deger performed at the MMEA Midwinter in-service clinic. To prepare for the convention appearance, the orchestra worked with All-State Orchestra conductor David MacKenzie of the University of Southern Oregon. The program included: Rimsky-Korsakoff, *Dance of the Tumblers* arr. Dackow; Humperdinck, *Evening Prayer*, arr. Del

Borgo; Handel, And He Shall Purify (from The Messiah), arr. Bender; Hofeldt, The Gift; Rimsky-Korsakov, The Story of the Calendar Prince (from Scheherezade) arr. Hopkins; Gazda, Appalachian Sunrise; and Handel, The Hallelujah Chorus (from The Messiah), arr. Frost. At the center of the program was Camerata Suite by Stillwater composer James Hall. The second movement, named

Still Waters by the students, reflects the serenity of life in the St. Croix Valley and the warmth and closeness of friends and family. Since its premier in 1998, Still Waters has become the theme song of the Camerata Strings, with the hope of establishing a tradition for future Camerata orchestras.
