A Rhythm A Week | Anne C. Witt | One octave scales in rhythms. | Key signatures, rhythmic accuracy; bow direction, ensemble; (label bowings, new/tricky counting)

EE for Strings–Book 2 | Allen, Gillespie, Hayes | Pages: 18–19 & 38–43 | Shifting, triplets, double stops, **§** time, extensions

ET for Strings | Allen, Gillespie, Hayes | Pages: 2–9 | Shifting, harmonics, string crossings in position; (white out/change fingerings)

Muller Rusch–Book 3 | Muller, Rusch | Pages 74–79 | Shifting (white out finger numbers)

First Position Etudes | Applebaum | Unison etudes in C, G, D, F & B-flat | Articulation uniformity, dotted quarters, bowing patterns/slurs, key signatures

27 Etudes for Strings | Knechtel | Unison etudes | Bowing—motion & wrist flexibility, bowings, accidentals, strings crossings, double stops

Winning Rhythms | Ayola | Lines of rhythm | Ensemble awareness, group pulse,

rhythmic review, labeling the counting

Uni-Tunes–Book I | Nunez | Unison in Keys G, D, C | Note reading, rhythm, naturals within key signature

Solo Time for Strings–Bk 2 | Highland/ Etling | Unison solo | Note reading, rhythm awareness, stamina
